My dear Mr. White:

Upon my return to the city Saturday night, I found in my office information from the President of the State Teachers' Association to the effect that in view of the statement that Mr. Marshall could not reach the seat of the Convention before the 27th inst., it would not be necessary for him to come to Florida for the purpose of addressing the Convention.

It was pointed out that most of the teachers would leave the Convention for their homes and other places on the 26th inst., that being Friday. The business of the Convention would be finished by that time and it is not likely that any considerable number of them would remain over until Saturday.
