Dear Mr. White:

I am informed that some one or two states have offered bills to their Legislatures, since the Gaines' case was decided by the U.S. Supreme Court, to allow negroes to enter universities that are operated for white people only, particularly in those cases where no opportunity is offered in negro institutions to pursue the course carried on by the white universities.

In view of the fact that the Florida Legislature has just opened in a sixty day session I am thinking of urging the introduction of such a bill in the Florida Legislature, so I will thank you if you have a copy of the bill that has been proposed, as I understand it, in North Carolina and Missouri, to send it to me.
