Dear McGill:

The whole question of appealing the teachers' salary case in Florida seems to sum up to this - We doubt that we can do more harm than to get a decision throwing the case out on the technical ground taken by the Supreme Court of Florida. For this reason it seems that we have a much better possibility of getting a favorable decision on the broad point of the Fourteenth Amendment. We have therefore agreed that we should work on applying for certiorari to see whether or not we will have a possible chance. To this end I would appreciate it very much if you would let us have your suggestions so that we can work together on it. We do not have much time and I am very busy on the Virginia and Maryland cases.
