Dear McGill:

Thanks for your letter of October 9th notifying us of the appeal of the Florida Teachers' Case to the United States Supreme Court. As it stands now, we are to file our second Teachers' Salary Case in the Federal Courts of Virginia next week. The Maryland Case in the Federal Court in Baltimore will be heard the following week on October 26.

If everything goes as expected we will be able to start work on the Florida case not later than the beginning of November. I think we should have it well under way so that you could report to the meeting of the Florida State Teachers' Association that the case was actually on its way to the Supreme Court.

The Tennessee Cases against the University of Tennessee have all been drafted and will be filed this week. Houston and Redmond will file the cases against the University of Missouri not later than the first of next week. From all indications we certainly will have a rather busy winter on these education cases.
